WHITE

1. **Paintaferro Grillo**
 2011 (Italy)£3.65 £4.90 £14.55
A varietal native to Sicily, the Grillo is the most wide-spread and famous white varietal on the island and was historically used for production of Marsala.
Spicy melon, pear and pineapple notes are forward and fresh, leading to an aftertaste of salted butter and spice flavours.
2. **Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc**
 2012 (Chile)£3.75 £4.95 £14.75
Bouquet of citrus, apples, a touch of grass, mineral and flower notes. Very crisp and clean.
3. **Le Magnolie Pinot Grigio**
 2011 (Italy)..... £3.95 £5.30 £15.60
A perfect example of this Italian classic wine. Pale yellow with pink reflections. This wine has a dry, crisp taste with a finely balanced acidity and heaps of flavour.
This wine is made from 100% Pinot Grigio!
4. **Hunt Chardonnay 2011**
 (Australia)£4.40 £5.95 £17.40
Pale straw in colour with aromas of apple and melon complexed by partial oak fermentation. These characters carry through on the full-flavoured palate, which shows the fine balance and a crisp, lingering finish.
5. **Luberon Blanc 2011 Perrin (France) ...** £16.60
Bright yellow with tints of green. Loads of green fruit, wheat and hazelnut on the palate, very soft, delicate and aromatic.
6. **The Cloud Factory Sauvignon Blanc**
 2011 (New Zealand) £20.60
This wine has a bouquet of passion fruit and gooseberries, on taste it is complex with rich gooseberry and tropical fruits flavours and a wonderful long finish. Highly recommended!
7. **Chablis La Lotte 2011 (France)** £25.70
Gunflint on the nose with a hint of smoke. The fruit on the palate is showing signs of a creamy, buttery core but is restrained and soft. Crisp and dry on the finish.
8. **Sancerre Pre Semele 2011 (France).....**£26.60
A classic Sancerre with freshly picked gooseberries and streaked with dry minerality on the palate.

ROSE

9. **Barton Shiraz Rose 2011**
 (South Africa)£4.20 £5.60 £16.50
Delicate raspberries and strawberries can be found on the nose which follow to the palate. A balanced acidity adds freshness and life to the wine.

10. **Paintaferro Primitivo**
 2011 (Italy)£3.65 £4.90 £14.55
A super easy drinking red with jam, blueberry, black pepper, cherry, plum, cranberry, and liquorice flavours. Very complex for the price!
11. **Tierra Alta Merlot**
 2011 (Chile)£3.75 £4.95 £14.75
Flavours of ripe plum and blackberries on the palate lead to a soft and Moorish finish.
12. **Vega Piedra Rioja Tinto**
 2010 (Spain).....£3.95 £5.30 £15.60
Red ruby in colour with violet tones; well balanced black fruit – balm like flavours and vanilla.
Powerful complex and silky smooth taste in the mouth.
13. **Chianti DOCG**
 2010 (Italy)£4.20 £5.60 £16.50
Deep intense ruby colour. Fine and intense bouquet, rich with notes of ripe black cherry and noble woods, yielding to blackberry and hints of vanilla and cocoa.
14. **Hunt Shiraz 2011 (Australia) £17.40**
Deep red in colour. Expect red berry and liquorice aromas with cedar and wood smoke. Spicy plum and mocha flavours are enhanced by French oak maturation. The wine has excellent balance with a lingering finish.
15. **58 Guineas Claret Bordeaux Rouge**
 2010 (France) £17.80
On the nose, fresh and forward, lively red fruit backed by good depth – true claret typicity, youthful but unmistakable. On the palate, round medium-bodied, perfectly balanced flavours of youthful red fruit with claret backbone, easily enjoyable on its own or with food.
16. **Scuola Grande Valpolicella Ripasso**
 2009 (Italy) £23.80
Aged in large oak casks, this fresh Ripasso makes good use of minimal wood intervention that comes forth as light spice and cinnamon. The core of this wine, however, consists of pulsing black fruit and mature cherry.
17. **Gigondas Domaine Raspail-Ay**
 2009 (France) £34.50
Full-bodied with elegance married to considerable substance and power, a beautifully textured mouthfeel lead to a rich long finish.

18. **Le Magnolie Prosecco (Italy)** £18.95

*Pale straw yellow in colour with green tints.
Presents a fine delicate scent of fresh fruit
and flowers.*

19. **House Champagne (France)** £39.50

*This champagne shows fine mousse in the glass
and fresh floral aromas mixed with characteristic
sweet, doughy overtones, which are balanced by
richer fruit, peach skin characters and classic
baked biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish.*

20. **Veuve Clicquot Non Vintage
(France)** £57.00

*Rich with elegant biscuity flavours, this really
is a fine Champagne. Perfect for celebrating
your hole in one!*
